

## Editor's Note

Welcome to issue number 3 of volume 25. This issue marks a transition in the publication of *Analytic Teaching*. With this issue we are inaugurating two changes. First, until now we have published only two issues in each volume. Some readers may recall that we stated that we would publish as many issues in a single volume as we had accepted articles (with an issue being about 64 pages). It appears that the number of accepted articles has increased to the degree that we have increased the number of issues. That is only particularly true. The more salient reason for having three issues is because we have chosen to follow the rest of the publishing world and to organize our volumes around the calendar year rather than the academic year. So we have extended volume 25 to 3 issues. Volume 26 will begin with the 2006 calendar year. This change has been made possible because we are publishing on-line with no subscription cost. It would have been too complicated financially to change publication dates while accommodating subscribers.

It was good to see many subscribers and contributors at the ICPIC conference in Mexico City this summer. It was an engaging conference with great camaraderie.
