

Welcome to the first on-line issue of *Analytic Teaching: The Community of Inquiry Journal*. We are no longer publishing the journal in a paper version. Most aspects of the journal will remain the same; however there are a few minor changes. First, the preferred method for submitting articles is via a Word email attachment (see how to submit). Second, we are now requiring an abstract. The abstract not only help the perspective reader decide what to read but also we be helpful in aiding peer reviewer in selecting which articles they wish to review.

The other change relates to what we think is an effective use of the on-line format. As we are not tied tightly to a publication schedule, each article will be published as it arrives and is successfully reviewed. In order to keep the appearance of the journal as much like the paper version as possible, we will maintain the size of each issue at about 60 pages. Once we reach about 60 pages, we will start a new issue. This may mean that there is one issue a year or it may more likely mean that there will be 3 or 4 issues a year (if the current rate of quality articles keep up).

We are publishing the first article without cover art – that should be included by the end of this month (October). Please be patient, this is a work in progress.
