

Sister Bernyne Stark Solidarity Scholarship

This scholarship was named for Bernyne Stark, FSPA because of her commitment to global solidarity in her fostering of inter-country study opportunities. Sr. Bernyne initiated the first student travel abroad in the late 60s and became affectionately known as the "Viterbo Travel Agent" for a number of years when she was teaching French at Viterbo between 1964 and 1995.

APPLICATION

<u>Allocation Guidelines</u>: The Sister Bernyne Solidarity Scholarship will provide for a one-time award to a student who is planning for a study abroad in the summer, fall, or spring semester. <u>Purpose/Eligibility:</u> The recipient of the scholarship shall be a VU student planning for a department-approved study abroad. The recipient must be in good standing with the university, have a minimum GPA of 3.0, and demonstrate interest in cultural appreciation.
