-  Ask your counselor when college representatives will be visiting your school.
-  Make a list of college features that interest you after researching them online and talking with family, friends, college grads, teachers, and counselors.
-  Research financial aid with your family at *StudentAid.ed.gov*.

-  Have a meeting with your counselor and family to discuss ways to improve your college preparations and to help with your college selection process.
-  Register for AP exams (if applicable), which are administered in May.
-  Consider seeking out free ACT/SAT preparation tools and practice tests.
-  Register in advance for the ACT, SAT, or both.
Most students take a standardized test in the spring of junior year. Students are able to retake these exams. Viterbo will use your best score for admission and scholarship consideration.
-  Create a list of colleges you are interested in and start researching them.
-  Summer before senior year: visit colleges.
-  Finish the year strong for college admission reviews. You should start applying to colleges the fall of your senior year.
