Other Voter Registration Pitfalls to Avoid:

- o WI residents must bring their WI Drivers license when registering AND when voting!
- On-campus students: the Proof of Residency requirement is only met with **both** a signed Viterbo
 University student ID **and** the Proof of Residency/Tuition Statement. To access or print your tuition
 statement off <u>VitNet</u>, follow these steps:
 - On VitNet, click on "Students"
 - Scroll down to "Financial Aid" and click "Tuition Statement—Proof of Residency"
 - Enter the semester, click, and print all pages of your proof of residency letter. The actual mailing address located at the bottom right hand corner is critical, both for your registration and because it's the address you should list in the "The Address Where You Live" field on the form.
