Delivery Format

- Students are members of a learning cohort, starting the program together and progressing through the same curriculum to build relationships and a strong learning community.
- Coursework is completed online. Over the course of the program, you'll participate in two on-campus sessions (two days each) to connect with your learning community in person.
- Online courses are 7–8 weeks in duration and are taken one course at a time. Students complete the program in 24 months.
- Non-business majors can prepare for our MBA program by completing four online academic leveling modules to gain competency in core business areas.
