

Voter Information for Wisconsin

Wisconsin Registration Requirements

- You must be a U. S. Citizen.
- You must be at least 18 years old on Election Day.
- You must have resided in your election district at least 28 days.
- You must have acceptable photo ID. Go to www.bringit.wi.gov for acceptable forms. NOTE: The Viterbo Student IDs issued after October 2019 are voter-compliant.
- You are not currently serving a sentence including probation or parole for a felony conviction.
- You are not otherwise disqualified from voting.

How do I register to vote or change my address?

- By mail: <https://www.myvote.wi.gov>. Follow the instructions carefully when completing the form. You must provide a copy of one of the forms of POR specified on the instructions. Print the form, sign it and mail it with POR to the municipal clerk **at least 20** days before the election.
- In Person: In the City Clerk's Office between 8:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., Monday-Thursday, but no later than the Friday before an election (see Elections & Voting [webpage](#) for specific hours the two weeks before each election). Proof of residence is required.
- On Election Day: You may register to vote at your assigned polling place the day of the election although it is recommended that you register in advance. Proof of residence is required. Information on polling place, election times, documents needed for voter registration are available at <https://www.myvote.wi.gov>.

How do I obtain an absentee ballot?

- You may request an absentee ballot through [My Vote Wisconsin](#).
- Voters registered in the City of La Crosse may use the Absentee Ballot Request form on the City Clerk's [Absentee Voting](#) page. Or, you may send a **signed** letter or email request, indicating your name, residence address, the address the ballot should be mailed, and a contact number.
- Acceptable Photo ID must also accompany the Absentee Ballot request. Go to www.bringit.wi.gov for acceptable forms.
- Mail the application or letter to the municipal clerk serving the municipality where you are registered to vote. The last day a municipal clerk may honor written requests for an absentee ballot is five days before an election.
- In the office of the City Clerk (400 La Crosse Street) starting two weeks before each election (see Elections & Voting [webpage](#) for specific hours the two weeks before each election).

Where do I vote?

- Viterbo University students who live on campus in Bonaventure Hall, Marian Hall, McDonald Terrace, Rose Terrace, Treacy House, or La Verna Apartments vote at Coulee Recovery Center, 933 Ferry St., La Crosse, WI, 54601.
- Viterbo University students who live on campus in Canticle House or Clare Apartments vote at the Southside Neighborhood Center, 1300 6th Street South, La Crosse, WI, 54601.

Election day voting hours - The polls are open from 7 a.m.–8 p.m.
