



FRESHMAN SCHOLARSHIPS AND FINANCIAL AID

Education is one of the best investments you will make. While our graduates do quite well (Viterbo graduates have a 99% placement rate and are ranked in the top 10 nationally for jobs that pay well and have meaning), this is not an investment you need to make on your own. Viterbo is here to help.

Viterbo offers academic merit scholarships, plus additional competitive scholarships for some areas of study, performing arts, and athletics, as well as need-based financial aid.

SCHOLARSHIP LEVELS

Admitted freshmen are considered for these academic merit scholarships based on their academic marks—in particular, cumulative high school GPA and test scores. Admitted students have until **March 1** to submit improved test scores or transcripts to attempt to increase their academic scholarship. Students living off campus will have awards reduced by \$2,000. These awards are renewable and are meant to be annual awards for four years, provided that students maintain a minimum GPA at Viterbo (see below for amounts and renewal criteria).

NEED-BASED FINANCIAL AID

To apply for need-based financial aid (grants, particular scholarships, work-study, or loans), file the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) after Oct. 1, 2016. To ensure consideration for all financial aid options, complete the FAFSA and any additional required documentation prior to Viterbo's priority deadline of **Feb. 1, 2017**. \$1,000 (one-year scholarship)

Must have 3.0 GPA or higher. Legal guardian must have attended Viterbo (45+ credits).

\$1,000

NEW: Parent or legal guardian must be an alumnus. Apply and be admitted prior to the deadline. No additional application necessary.

College Readiness Scholarship

\$1,000

NEW: Must participate in an approved college readiness program. Apply and be admitted prior to the deadline. No additional application necessary.

Deadline: Feb. 1, 2017

Health Science Scholarship

Up to full tuition

Must have an ACT of 24 or higher and be a pre-health, science, or math major (nursing excluded).

Deadline: Jan. 20, 2017

On-campus competition: Feb. 10, 2017

Hope Diocesan

\$6,000

Must be a graduating senior from a Catholic high school in the La Crosse Diocese and have a 3.25 GPA or higher and an ACT of 26 or higher.

Deadline: Feb. 15, 2017

Nightingale Nursing Scholarship

Up to \$6,000

Must have a 3.25 GPA or higher, an ACT of 25 or higher, and be a nursing major.

Deadline: Jan. 6, 2017

On-campus competition: Feb. 3, 2017

Professional Diversity

\$2,500

Must have a 2.75 GPA or higher and must be an ethnic minority. Preference may be given to those majoring in nursing, education, social work, or dietetics.

Deadline: Feb. 15, 2017

Project SUCCESS Scholars

Up to \$10,000

Must have a 3.0 GPA or higher, an ACT of 22 or higher, plan to major in biology or environmental biology (pre-health students are excluded), and have financial need as determined by the FAFSA.

Deadline: Feb. 15, 2017

Russel and Vera Smith

Amount varies (apply each year)

Must have a 3.5 GPA or higher, be in the top 25 percent of their class, and intend to study in the Dahl School of Business.

Deadline: Feb. 15, 2017

Talent: Art

Up to \$1,000

Must be majoring in an art program. Portfolio review required.

Deadline: March 1, 2017

Talent: Athletic

Amount varies

Contact sport-specific coach. Decision made by the coach.

Deadline: Varies by sport

Talent: Theatre and Music Theatre

Up to \$2,000

Must be admitted into the theatre or music theatre programs. Audition required.

Deadline: April 1, 2017

Talent: Vocal Music and Piano

Up to \$2,000

Must be admitted into the music programs. Audition required.

Deadline: March 6, 2017

Xcel Energy

\$625 per year/\$2,500 total

Must be a female, majoring in science or math, with a 3.5 GPA or higher and an ACT of 23 or higher.

Deadline: Feb. 15, 2017
