**CONCERT CHOIR** is an integral part of the strong musical tradition of Viterbo University and is required for all music majors. This 50-voice choral ensemble is open to any university student and performs both sacred and secular classical choral literature as well as folk songs and spirituals. In December 2009 the ensemble travelled to London to perform Handel's *Messiah* in a festival concert at Southwark Cathedral on New Year's Day. An entrance audition is required to participate in Concert Choir. Auditions are open to all Viterbo students.
