In a unique collaboration, Viterbo University and Western Technical College offer the Associate of Arts and Associate of Science degrees. These two-year general education programs are a gateway to a bachelor's degree. Upon completion, students can continue on to earn a bachelor's degree at Viterbo in a variety of majors.

Why Viterbo?

The Viterbo University Associate of Arts and Associate of Science degree programs:

- allow students to complete general education coursework in as little as two years.
- feature a blended tuition rate and financial aid opportunities.
- are flexible, with classes available days, evenings (one evening a week), and online.
- feature classes at Viterbo, Western Technical College, or at various Western regional centers.

Features of the Curriculum

The general education program encourages a broad knowledge base in the liberal arts and the development of specific core abilities, such as communication skills and the ability to think critically. It provides opportunities for students to recognize the dignity and value of individuals and cultures, and to develop personally as productive, creative, and empathetic persons.
