The Bachelor of Liberal Studies is an inter-disciplinary liberal arts degree that allows students the wide range of choice and flexibility needed to tailor their courses of study to their own unique interests and needs. It is ideal for students with interests outside of, or across, traditionally defined areas or for those seeking a bachelor's degree to meet pre-professional goals, such as the entrance requirements to law school. It accommodates the use of students' credits from an Associate of Arts degree program or from an incomplete bachelor's degree program.
