2. Students must pass the PPST prior to Admission to Teacher Education.
3. Students must earn a minimum of 128 semester credits, 43 semester credits must be upper division (courses with a 300/400 number)
4. Students must earn a minimum grade of "C" in all Professional Program Requirements.
5. Students must earn a minimum grade point average of 2.50 in the General Education Requirements.
6. Students must pass Praxis II exam prior to Admission to Student Teaching.
