The dance program at Viterbo University is designed to provide academic and studio training in the areas of ballet, jazz, tap, modern and musical theatre dance. Its goals are two-fold: 1) to offer training the student wishing to pursue more intensely the study of dance within a minor program; and 2) to further specific objectives of the music theatre program. Dance performance opportunities are open by audition to all Viterbo students and include music theatre productions, operas, and Viterbo dance concerts.

There will be a qualifying audition for those students who wish to test out of Fundamentals of Dance or Introduction to Dance Techniques, and/or the beginning levels of other dance classes.
