## SCHOLARSHIPS AND AWARDS

The goal of Viterbo University is to encourage academic merit, address special talent, and recognize the value of enrollments in specific programs of study. Listed below are Viterbo University's Scholarships and Awards for new, full-time, freshman students intending to enroll in the academic year of 2012–13. Complete an application for state and federal aid (via the FAFSA), which will allow us to work with each family/student to determine the total assistance available to that student based on merit, need, talent, and the major program of study. Recipients will have award reduced by \$2,000 if they reside off campus.

#### President's Scholarship

*\$11,000 per year (renewable)*

- Last year's recipients had an average ACT score of 27, SAT score of 1300 and an average GPA of 3.80.
- Renewable for four years (beyond, on appeal) with an earned minimum Viterbo GPA of 3.30.

#### Dean's Scholarship

*\$9,000 per year (renewable)*

- Last year's recipients had an average ACT score of 23, SAT score of 1140 and an average GPA of 3.60.
- Renewable for four years (beyond, on appeal) with an earned minimum Viterbo GPA of 3.00.

#### Hallmark Scholarship

*\$7,000 per year (renewable)*

- Last year's recipients had an average ACT score of 21, SAT score of 1060 and a GPA of 3.20.
- Renewable for four years (beyond, on appeal) with an earned minimum Viterbo GPA of 2.75.

#### Heritage Scholarship

*\$5,000 per year (renewable)*

- Students must contact the admission office to determine eligibility for this award.
- Renewable for four years (beyond, on appeal) with an earned minimum Viterbo GPA of 2.75.

## NEED-BASED FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

To apply for need-based financial assistance (grants, scholarships, work study, and loans—federal or state), file the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and complete Viterbo's Institutional Data Form (IDF) between Jan. 1 and March 15. 1 - \$1,000

Must have GPA of 3.0 or higher. Legal guardian must have attended Viterbo (45 + credits).

**Deadline:** March 15, 2012

### Army ROTC

Up to full tuition

Based on select eligibility criteria.

**Deadline:** Until all scholarships are awarded

### Health Science Competition

1 - Full Tuition (renewable)

27 - Amount varies depending on competition results (renewable)

Must have an ACT score of 25 or higher and be a pre-health, science, or math major (nursing excluded).

**Deadline:** Jan. 23, 2012

On-campus competition: Feb. 17, 2012

### Hope Diocesan

1 - \$6,000 (renewable)

Must be current La Crosse Diocese High School senior and have a GPA of 3.25 or higher and an ACT score of 26 or higher.

**Deadline:** March 15, 2012

### Muriel Kuntz Dutcher Memorial

1 - \$2,500

Preference given to a graduate of Tomah High School area or surrounding high schools with a GPA of 3.5 or higher and show financial need.

Apply through financial aid office.

Applications accepted Jan. 5, 2012.

### Nightingale Nursing Competition

5 - Amount varies (renewable)

Scholarship recipients also earn direct admission into the professional nursing sequence.

**Deadline:** Nov. 1, 2011

On-campus competition: Nov. 18, 2011

### Professional Diversity

4 - \$2,500 each (renewable)

Must have a GPA of 2.75 or higher and must be an ethnic minority. Preference given to those majoring in nursing, education, social work, or dietetics.

**Deadline:** March 15, 2012

### Russel and Vera Smith

1 - up to \$5,000 (apply each year)

Must have a GPA of 3.5 or higher and be in the top 25 percent of class and major in the Dahl School of Business.

**Deadline:** March 15, 2012

### Talent: Athletic

Amount varies (renewable)

Contact sport-specific coach. Decision made by coach.

**Deadline:** Varies per sport

### Talent: Fine Arts

Amount varies (renewable)

Must be a fine arts major; talent review required.

Decision made by faculty.

**Deadline:** March 15, 2012

### Xcel Energy

2 - \$625 per year/\$2,500 total (renewable)

Must be a female majoring in science or math and have an ACT score of 23 or higher and a GPA of 3.5 or higher.

**Deadline:** March 15, 2012
