- IV. Mission Moment Samantha Totsky, Secretary of SDA
  - Thank you to those who donated to the Dietetics Pasta Dinner. The event was a success. The Alumni Board donated 14 gift cards for a total of \$405.00.
  - The event raised \$4,500.00 and had great attendance. 200 more people than expected attended and over 400 people were served.
  - Hospitality and Service was the Viterbo values applicable to describing this Pasta event.
  - Annual Pie Sales Traditional Apple pie, Pumpkin pie, Caramel Apple Crumble, gluten free pumpkin bread sold until November 14<sup>th</sup>.
  - November 19<sup>th</sup> will hand out pies in foods lab on the second floor of the Nursing Building.
- V. University Update Glena Temple
  - Recognition of Juan Jimenez for his two years of faithful service and ethical leadership as the Alumni Board President. Juan was also congratulated as being named one of the Rising Stars of Coulee Region.







- Viterbo Updates
  - o 99% Placement rate for Viterbo students.
  - $\circ$  4-year graduation rate increased to above 50%.
  - Accreditation visit finished institution of quality, visit to campus for 3 days and then wait for written report now waiting for the results of that visit.
  - Engineering program started off with 15 students and there's a new with a doctorate program to be launched in January – the Ed.D. in Counselor Education and Supervision
  - Deb Murray WI counseling Educator of the Year Bill Bakalars received the Professional Counselor of the Year Award.
  - Master's Nutrition Sciences is underway.
  - Proposing a different mission structure with the sponsorship change.
  - Physical plant project to acknowledge sisters as founders different projects being proposed.
  - Reinhart Center will be transitioned into the Welcome Center and this project was recently approved.
  - Glena will move over to the Fine Arts Center which is being renovated and scheduled for completion this spring. Renovations will start November 19<sup>th</sup>.
  - Campaign Fine Arts Center lobby upgrade bathrooms, floors, lighting, box office, hospitality suite.
  - Alumni Awards amazing stories at lunch but not enough people hearing it. Criteria of individuals showing values in career and success in their field.
    Opportunities for students to network with the award winners. Pass on ideas to Kathy if you have them.
  - Opportunities to name classrooms and offices in Murphy Center for renovation.
  - Enrollment rates up with a decline in adult learning as teachers no longer need to take credits for licensures.
  - VP of Advancement –interviewed three candidates and the goal is to have someone in place by the beginning of 2019.
  - Events 7 Rivers (Nov. 9<sup>th</sup>); Advent meeting end of November; Women's Volleyball team ranked 5<sup>th</sup> in nation and starting NAIA playoffs week of Nov. 26.

History of mission – Founded by FSPA. With the sisters aging and the change of the sponsorship, the Franciscan mission has passed from the sisters to the ministry committee and employees of Viterbo. A committee was needed to organize mission activities. The committee would have a low budget. Redesign Mission Integration Committee, which has a wide range in members. Celebration of FSPA (Founders week) and St. Francis over the course of two separate weeks. Training of employees around mission and identity.
