- Meeting weekly with President-Elect Glena Temple during her transition. Inauguration tentatively scheduled for Friday, April 7. More information to come.
- Searches are underway for a VP of enrollment management and a VP of academic affairs to replace Glena. The goal is to hire the enrollment manager first. Two other internal searches are underway, one to replace Ted Wilson as the dean of the college of education, science, and math. Jerry Kember is the interim dean. The second is the dean of the college of nursing, health, and human behavior, as Mary Lu Gerke is retiring. Communications and marketing will be separated. Communications will move under enrollment and marketing will be advancement and university relations with Wendell. Hope to fill the enrollment position by February 1, with interviews in December. Academic affairs dean interviews will take place in February for arrival in summer.

- 13 nearby institutions are coming to campus for 7 Rivers Undergraduate Research Symposium this weekend. It's an opportunity to showcase the university. Students present their research on Friday.

IV. Undergraduate Research and Viterbo Rings

Kirsten Gabriel 6 pm

Kirsten Gabriel presented information on student undergraduate research. The 14th annual undergrad research symposium consists of 215 participants from Viterbo and 13 other campuses. All events are free, and alumni are welcome. Hours are 10:10 a.m. to 4:30, with student presentations from 12 to 4 p.m. The schedule is on the website.

Kirsten also invited board members to participate in "Viterbo Rings" for The Salvation Army. This is the November Service Saturday event. Service Saturday began last February. One Saturday a month faculty, staff, and students volunteer in the community. They meet for breakfast in the morning, go out into the community for 3 hours of service at different sites, then return to campus for a reflective lunch. The Spirit of St. Francis Service Saturday was held in conjunction with Feast of St. Francis in October. Alumni are invited to participate and may sign up online to partner with the Viterbo community for this event.

- V. Derek Cortez requested the board's input on a new initiative, "Perspectives," which would potentially engage Viterbo alumni to connect on a deeper level through learning and professional development opportunities. Derek would facilitate group discussions. Board members are open to pursuing this idea but would like to see some financial benefit tied to it.
- VI. Gretel Stock-Kupperman explained the HLC accreditation process, timeline, and how the alumni board can be instrumental in the process. In April she will request alumni feedback on how Viterbo is meeting standards for accreditation. This is an opportunity to reflect on mission, instruction, etc. Let others know about this opportunity, also.
