IV. University Update

Glena Temple

5:35 p.m.

- Thank you for participation in inauguration and day of service. Highlight was Service Saturday. 330 individuals participated from 8:30 a.m. to 1 p.m. at 19 different community sites and alumni out of the area. Students, family members, alumni, staff. Students have suggested an annual year-end gathering to celebrate Service Saturdays.
- Memorial service was held Monday for student Erin Rud, freshman nursing major, who passed away as the result of an accident the week prior to inauguration.
- Sr. Carlene Unser passed away this week. She was instrumental in the art department.
- Nursing on the Green took place today as part of Scholars' Day, the art show opened last night.
- Class of 2016 placement rates: 99% success rate was retained, 93% in-field placement within 6 months of graduation. College of Business and Leadership had 100% placement. 30% are working within the city of La Crosse, and 50% within an hour radius. Suggested placement as a future meeting topic.





- Personnel changes: VP Academic Affairs Tracy Stewart; Dean College of Nursing, Health, and Human Behavior Martha Scheckel from Winona State, Dean College of Education, Science and Mathematics Sara Cook.
- Engineering program partnership was announced. Viterbo and WTC will collaborate. Probably a four-year general engineering degree and a two plus two with WTC. This would require building one lab on campus as well as using WTC's lab for upper level classes. Currently interviewing for one person to help start the program, hopefully finalizing in next month.
- Launching a few new graduate programs in 2018. Traditional undergrad enrollment is holding steady. A little down from last year but should do better with marketing campaign. Growth seems to be at the graduate level so that's an area of emphasis.
- More resources will be directed into residennce life and student engagement on campus. Focus is student engagement instead of campus activities, coupled with resident life. Engage freshmen to stay on weekends and to get involved with Service Saturdays and other events. Students are very attached to their majors but not necessarily to Viterbo outside of their majors.
- V. Higher Learning Commission-Alumni Board Feedback

- Naomi provided a purpose, structure, and timeline overview and extended thanks to alumni board members' work in reviewing the claims. So far they've received 55 responses to survey through 13 alumni board members.
- Have started the work of writing the 50-page argument to submit to the commission next summer. Must make convincing argument that we meet the criteria. Will also own the areas for growth. Will link the arguments to evidence. After getting feedback the claims will be revised so they resonate with community members. Will rewrite and bring the draft back next spring. They'll submit pages and evidence a month before consultants come to campus October 2018. Commission is looking for quality and sustainability.
- Ten claims were submitted for input from various groups. Groups were asked if the claim resonates with you, what would you add, does the argument sit well with you.
