- Fall semester is underway. 295 freshmen moved in. Less than last year but up from the year before. 110 transfer students. 9 countries are represented by 18 international students.
- Thanks to alumni board members Cassandra, Margaret, and Jessica for handing out water at Move-In Day. This year university employees also assisted, along with faculty and students.
- Changed the welcome and blessing ceremony. Five students presented our core values. President Temple suggested asking them to speak at a future alumni board meeting. A new addition to the ritual was a clap line for new students and family as they leave the auditorium.
- Service Saturday was held for new students at 30 sites in the community. We'll make a few tweaks for next year.
- Working to get students to stay on campus for Labor Day weekend. We always lose a few students that weekend. We have talked to parents about it and have planned many campus activities.
- New leadership team: VP Academic Affairs Tracy Stewart, VP for Enrollment Management Michelle Kronfeld; VP for Student Affairs Rick Trietley; Dean, College of Nursing Health & Human Behavior Martha Scheckel, and Dean of Education, Science and Math, Sara Cook.





- Added residence life and student engagement staff in Student Affairs. Created a director of student life position. We're putting resources into Student Affairs to increase retention and to recognize the importance of activities outside the classroom and educating the whole student.
- 2 new members on Board of Trustees, Sr Georgie Christensen and John McHugh of Kwik Trip.
- Third semester retention rate was 80% last year. This year it was 73%, but figures are not final yet. However, the 4-year graduation rate is up. It was below 30% a few years ago and is now up to 41%, surpassing our peer groups.
- Priorities this year: accreditation work and campus diversity initiatives are high on the list of needs to address. Scott Stene is starting to work with veterans on campus. We hired a veteran point of contact in the admissions office. We are strengthening services to veterans on campus and to the veteran population in La Crosse.
- Launching new academic programs. Engineering recruiting begins fall 2018 in partnership with WTC. We will be fundraising for one lab on campus and the partnership with WTC is on the 2 plus 2 program.
- Starting a counselor education doctoral program. The closest comparable program is in St. Cloud. It is a highly-recruited area of psychology so we should see a lot of applications quickly. No official announcement yet, as it is not yet approved by the Higher Learning Commission.
- Two proposals submitted for master's degree were approved by Board of Trustees. Need approval from Higher Learning Commission. Mayo School of Anesthesiology partners with UWL and will require doctorate. Tentative approval obtained from Higher Learning Commission. Also are going year-round with nursing but not changing the curriculum. Students could finish in three years. This is still in planning stages.
- Launching men's volleyball, competitive dance and cheering, and e-gaming.
- Branding update: 4 themes were brought forward and a survey is coming soon.
- Proposing that employees be allowed to volunteer during the work day.
- Fundraising: Viterbo has many students with financial need. Student emergency fund helps students stay in school. Wendell is working with the Center for Student Success on this initiative. Alumni could consider donating to this fund.
