

Graduate Placement Report: Viterbo University Class of 2011: Bachelor Degree Graduates

(December 2010, May 2011, and July 2011 Graduates)

The overall placement rate for the class of 2011 is 96%.

This placement rate reflects the percentages of 2011 graduates who received a bachelor's degree and report that their primary activity is enrollment in graduate/professional school or other continuing education; service in a branch of the armed forces; participation in volunteer service, such as AmeriCorps or the Peace Corps; or employment, either on a full-time or part-time basis in or out of their fields of study.

All percentages in this report are based on the total number of graduates reporting, not the total number of graduates. The 2011 alumni reporting they are currently not working <u>and</u> not seeking employment are not included in the placement tabulations. In addition, percentage calculations at .5 or above have been rounded up to the nearest number and those below .5 have been rounded down to the nearest whole number.

A total of 426 individual students were listed on the registrar's official graduation lists as of October 15, 2011. Nine of these students completed studies in two majors (4 double degrees and 5 double majors), resulting in 435 majors being conferred. Information was gathered from 89 % of these graduates.

Only 20% of the class supplied salary data, resulting in averages that are not statistically significant. The 40% of the NURN graduates (n=31) who responded to the survey reported an average (mean) salary of \$57,000 per year. The 20% of the NURS graduates (n=14) who responded to the survey reported an average (mean) salary of \$50,000. The 50% of the OMGT graduates (n=12) who responded to the survey reported an average (mean) salary of \$44,000. All other majors had fewer than 10 people reporting salary data and are therefore not included in these calculations.

Definition of Terms/Explanations of Calculations

- 1. The "number reporting" category refers to graduates about whom data was gathered from sources deemed to be reliable sources by Career Services staff members. Those sources include information obtained via forms completed by graduates, telephone calls to the graduate or his/her family members, emails from the graduate, and information from professors and other personnel who have remained in contact with the student.
- 2. The "<u>not seeking</u>" category includes people who report they are not a part of the work force or continuing their educations or are not seeking employment at this time.
- 3. "Total reporting less not seeking" is the difference between number reporting and the number not seeking. Percentages for columns 4-12 are based on this number.
- 4. "Total placed overall" refers to those individuals about whom data was collected and who indicated they were employed either on a full-time or part-time basis in or out of their fields of study, enlisted in a branch of the armed forces, involved in volunteer service (e.g., AmeriCorps, Peace Corps) and/or enrolled in graduate/professional school or other continuing education. This number is the sum of placed in field and employed out of field. [% calculation: column 4/column 3]
- 5. The "placed in field" category includes individuals who are employed in their field of study, enlisted in a branch of the armed forces, involved in volunteer service (e.g., AmeriCorps, Peace Corps) and/or enrolled in graduate/professional school or other continuing education. (NOTE: This is based on students' self-disclosure of whether they perceive their employment related or not related to their education) This number is the sum of employed in field, military, volunteer service, grad/professional school, and other continuing education. [%calculation: column 5/column 3]
- 6. The "employed in field" includes individuals who report being required to obtain a specific major for their current employment positions, or whose work requires a college degree and/or utilizes the knowledge/skills acquired during their college educations. Graduates with double majors who are working in fields related to one of their majors are listed as "employed in field" for their respective listings in both majors. [% calculation: column 6/column 3]
- 7. Individuals listed in the "military" column are those who report their primary activity is in a branch of the armed forces. [% calculation: column 7/column 3]
- 8. The "volunteer service" category includes individuals who report their primary activity is in a volunteer or service organization. [% calculation: column 8/column 3]
- 9. The "graduate/professional school" category lists individuals who report that their primary activity is attending a graduate school, professional educational, or post-baccalaureate program [% calculation: column 9/column 3]

- 10. The "other continuing education" category includes individuals who report their primary activity is furthering their educations at a non-graduate level. [% calculation: column 10/column 3]
- 11. The "<u>employed out of field</u>" category includes individuals who report working in positions that do not require a bachelor's degree and/or positions that do not use the skills/knowledge they gained from their programs or majors. [% calculation: column 11/column 3]
- 12. The "available/seeking" category includes graduates who report they are not employed and are actively seeking employment. [% calculation: column 12/column 3]
- 13. The "primary placement in WI" reflects the number of students who are placed either in or out of field in the state of Wisconsin. [% calculation: column 13/column 4]


