ACADEMIC ADVISING

Students have both an academic advisor as well as a faculty advisor from their major. Students meet more frequently with their academic advisor earlier in their time at Viterbo and they will transition to working primarily with their faculty advisor as they progress through their program.

Academic Advisors meet regularly with students, hold workshops and group advising sessions to share information with students and work with students experiencing difficulty.


Faculty Advisor


