


University Enrollment Trends: Twelve-Month Unduplicated Enrollment









<u>Definitions</u>	
Unduplicated Credit Headcount	The count of all students enrolled in at least 1 credit of coursework between July 1 and June 30
Credit Hour	A unit of measurement representing the equivalent of approximately one hour of instruction per week over the entire 15-week term.
12-Mo. Unduplicated Full-Time Equivalent (FTE)	The 12-mo. unduplicated FTE is calculated by dividing the credit hour total by the average credit load that full-time students take on a typical academic plan. (For example, the undergraduate credit hour total of 57,115 for 2012-2013 is divided by 30 to get an FTE of 1,904.)
