Option to include crosscategorical special education license



Viterbo's elementary education degree completion program is an online program that provides a pathway to licensure as an elementary educator for those who do not currently hold a bachelor's degree or those who possess a bachelor's degree, but not a teaching license. Typically students enter this program having earned an associate degree or have 35-65 credits of undergraduate coursework.

In this 53-credit program students earn a B.S. in elementary education within two to three years.
