- e. A one-page written response addressing this statement: I believe this scholarship will enrich my nursing education, my ethical leadership and help prepare me for a career in nursing.
- f. Submit two letters of recommendation from persons familiar with the applicant's academic performance, leadership characteristics, and community service.

The scholarship is awarded annually and is renewable for one year provided the student maintains full-time status and a GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale. NOTE: Student required to reapply annually for funding.
