

CLEP EXAMS: INFORMATION FORM

College Level Examination Program at Viterbo University

CLEP exams are administered at Viterbo University in the Academic Resource Center (ARC) in Room 332 Murphy Center Monday through Friday from 7a.m. to be completed by 4 p.m. and only by appointment. You must register online with CLEP at: <http://clep.collegeboard.org/register/exam>. Registering for an exam provides you a ticket which you bring to the test site. Once you register and pay online, please contact Jane Eddy, Director of the ARC at 608-796-3194 or jleddy@viterbo.edu to schedule your Viterbo exam date. Students may register for two exams on a test date. **Students should be currently or intending to enroll at Viterbo.** CLEP exams consist of 90 minute multiple-choice objective tests. The English exam requires both an objective portion and an essay.
