Nursing and Bioethics Intertwined

In this presentation, the speaker will identify various ways that nurses are involved in bioethics, the importance of ethics education, and the value of engagement. She will use examples from clinical care, clinical research, policy development, and leadership to show the value that nurses bring to bioethics, and how important bioethics is to quality nursing practice.

ABOUT THE SPEAKER

Christine Grady is a nurse-bioethicist, senior investigator, and Chief of the Department of Bioethics at the National Institutes of Health Clinical Center. Her research focuses on clinical research ethics, including informed consent, vulnerability, study design, and recruitment, international research ethics and on ethical issues faced by nurses and other healthcare providers.

She is an elected fellow of the Hastings Center and the American Academy of Nursing, research fellow at Kennedy Institute of Ethics and an elected member of the National Academy of Medicine.

Dr. Grady holds a BS in nursing and biology from

Georgetown University, a MSN in community health nursing

from Boston College, and a PhD in philosophy from Georgetown University.
