In order to qualify for the guarantee, I understand I must satisfy the following terms:

- 1. Enter Viterbo University as a first-time, first-year student in the fall semester.
- 2. Choose a major by April 1 of my first academic year of enrollment. Declare major prior to first semester if major will be nursing, nutrition sciences, music education, music performance, music theatre, theatre, or engineering. For these majors, I will complete the appropriate prerequisites in order to enroll in required first-year courses by the time I start at the university.
- I understand that certain majors like nursing, education, and social work require separate admittance. If I'm not admitted to the professional program, this guarantee is null and void.
- 4. Change my major only if my academic advisor and faculty advisor determine that I can still meet all requirements for the new major without altering my four-year graduation date. I realize that the guarantee to graduate in four years will be null and void if it is determined that I cannot complete the new major in four years.
- 5. A new contract must be signed with a major and/or degree change.
- 6. Monitor my own degree progression by using Student Planning. Maintain enrollment in courses that help me progress toward my degree.
- 7. Maintain good academic standing as determined by the university and major department.
- 8. Maintain full-time enrollment.
- 9. Be current on all required payments to the university.
- 10. I understand the guarantee to graduate in four years will be null and void if I enroll in ESL courses.
- 11. I understand the guarantee to graduate in four years will be null and void if I enroll in more than one major or more than one minor.

If I comply with all the above terms, but am unable to graduate within four years due to the availability of required course(s), Viterbo University will substitute a different course(s), offer an independent study assignment, waive a course(s), and/or not charge tuition for any required course(s) for one semester beyond the anticipated four years. These options are the exclusive remedy for the guarantee.
