The latest COVID-19 relief bill **changed strict eligibility requirements for college students** allowing more students to qualify for FoodShare (SNAP) benefits. If you're struggling to afford groceries, FoodShare may be able to help.



**FoodShare helps people with limited money buy the food they need for good health.**

- **To Apply for FoodShare:**

- **To Check Your Balance:**  
Call Quest at 877-415-5164 or download the [ebtEDGE](#) app.
- **To Submit Documents:**  
Use the [MyACCESS](#) app to check benefits & upload items.

College students with limited income may now qualify. FoodShare work requirements are temporarily waived if students either:

- (1) Eligible for federal or state-funded work study programs during the regular school year
  - or -
- (2) Have an expected family contribution (EFC) of \$0 during the current academic year

This change helps more students get help from FoodShare who are facing burdens in finding employment during the economic downturn. Not sure if you'd qualify? The best way to find out is to apply!

## Statewide Agencies
