

Frequently Asked Questions

- Q: What size should I print my research or creative works poster?
 A: The recommended poster dimensions are 34"x44", landscape orientation.
 Viterbo University students should review the <u>VU Copy Center Poster Printing</u>
 <u>Guidelines</u> before printing their posters.
- Q: How long are oral presentations?
 A: Oral presenters will be given 10-12 minutes for their presentation, followed by 3-5 minutes for questions. Oral presenters will be asked to e-mail presentations to their room moderators in advance to decrease the transition time between presenters.
- Q: When will we receive confirmation that we have registered?
 A: All registrants- attendees and presenters- should have received an e-mail confirming registration when the registration form was completed.
- Q: When will I know when I present?
 A: Presentation schedules will be finalized the week of November 1st and should be posted on the website by Friday, November 5th. The first Oral presentation session will occur from 11:15-12:10 pm, both Poster Sessions will occur between 1:25-3:25 pm and the 2nd Oral presentation session will occur from 3:35-4:35 pm.
- Q: How long should my abstract be?
 A: Abstracts should not exceed 300 words. The Abstract Booklet should be sent to presenters for review by Thursday, November 4th. This document provides guidance on how to construct a strong abstract; this resource from the University of Wisconsin-Madison Writing Center provides discipline-specific examples of abstracts.
