Viterbo awards academic scholarships to new full-time transfer students enrolling in traditional undergraduate programs upon official acceptance. Online bachelor completion programs are excluded from these scholarships. Transfer students should also apply for additional scholarships and complete the FAFSA so we can award all federal, state, or institutional aid available based on merit, need, talent, and the major program of study. The FAFSA priority filing deadline for fall 2022 is **Feb. 1, 2022**.

GUIDELINES

- Award amount will remain unchanged regardless of earned Viterbo GPA.
- The academic scholarship is renewable for four years provided student maintains satisfactory academic progress (minimum 2.00 cumulative GPA).
- Recipient will have award reduced by \$1,000 if they reside off campus.

Students who transfer from Western Technical College may be eligible for the Jack and Rose Glendenning Scholarship and the Western Technical College Transfer Student Scholarship.

MILITARY
