Frequently Asked Questions

Q: What size should I print my research or creative works poster?
A: The recommended poster dimensions are 34"x44", landscape orientation.
Viterbo University students should review the <u>VU Copy Center Poster Printing</u> <u>Guidelines</u> before printing their posters.

- Q: What is my poster # and location?
- A: Poster #s and locations are on the schedules.

Q: How long are oral presentations?

A: Oral presenters will be given 10-12 minutes for their presentation, followed by 3-5 minutes for questions. Oral presenters should bring their presentations to the symposium on a flashdrive. Please arrive to your session at least ten minutes early to check in the moderator and get your presentation loaded.

Q: How do I know what time and where I am presenting?

Q: Can I attend lunch?
