### Exploration Courses

Students with any interest areas may add additional core curriculum courses as needed. Students should consult with their academic advisor to develop a course schedule that allows them to explore one or more of the areas below. Students with an interest in a Spanish major or minor or a Bachelor of Arts degree may add a Spanish course each semester.

#### For students with an interest in business

- Add ECON 102 – Microeconomics (3 cr.) and MGMT 101 – Intro to Business (1 cr.) fall semester
- Add ACCT 211 – Financial Accounting (3 cr.) and ECON 101 – Macroeconomics (3 cr.) spring semester
- Add MATH 112 – College Algebra (3 cr.) either semester, if needed based on placement

#### For students with an interest in education

- Add EDUC 150 – Introduction to Education (2 cr.) and MATH 155 – Mathematics: A Way of Thinking (3 cr.) fall semester
- Add EDUC 215 – Educational Psychology (3 cr.) spring semester

#### For students with an interest in the social sciences

- Add PSYC 171 – General Psychology (3 cr.) and/or SOCL 125 – Introduction to Sociology (3 cr.) and/or CRMJ 150 – Introduction to Criminal and Community Justice (3 cr.) and/or SOWK 210 – Introduction to Social Work (3 cr.)
- Add PSYC/SOCL 223 – Statistics for Social Sciences (3 cr.) and either CRMJ 203 – Policing in the Community (3 cr.), SOWK 210 – Introduction to Social Work (3 cr.), or PSYC 205 – Introduction to Chemical Dependency (3 cr.) spring semester

#### For students with an interest in the humanities

- Add any other core curriculum course (3 cr.)
- Add ECAS 100 – Truth, Beauty, Goodness (3 cr.)

#### For students with an interest in the natural sciences

- Add BIOL/CHEM 112 – Science Success (1 cr.), BIOL 160 or 161 – General Biology (4 cr.), and CHEM 120 – General Chemistry (4 cr.) fall semester
- Add BIOL 160/161 – General Biology (4 cr.) and CHEM 121 – General Chemistry (4 cr.) spring semester
- Add a math class as needed, depending on placement
