



Viterbo University Fine Arts Center Employee and Student Ticket Discounts

To further engage, educate, and energize the community through the power of live performance and cultural programming, the Viterbo University Fine Arts Center has created the following Viterbo student and employee ticket discount policies. They balance the Fine Arts Center's obligation to remain fiscally responsible and sustainable in its business operations while also recognizing the growth for participation and engagement.

Rush Tickets

Rush tickets will be available to anyone on a per performance basis. In general, Bright Star, Weber Center, and the Conservatory for the Performing Arts will have rush tickets available. Some performances at the Fine Arts Center and Weber Center spaces are presented and/or produced by other organizations. These performances may or may not be included in the rush ticket policy. A good way to check for rush ticket availability would be at: www.viterbo.edu/fine-arts-center under the specific show you want to attend.

- A designated rush ticket line will open one-hour prior to the performance at the box office, with rush tickets becoming available on a first come first served basis beginning 30 to 15 minutes before the performance.
- **Rush tickets will be 50% off ticket price, plus taxes and fees.**
- Limit one per person. All rush tickets are first come first served. No reservations or holds of any kind will be allowed. All purchases must be made in person.

Employee Tickets

The following ticket discounts will be offered for full-time, permanent part-time, retired, and emeritus employees.

- Rush tickets (see above)
- **10% off advertised package pricing for Bright Star Season of shows.** Notifications of this discount will generally happen in May of each year, with a physical flyer being put in all employees' mailboxes and multiple announcements being posted in VU Today prior to the beginning of employee package sales.
- **Two \$5 tickets (plus taxes and fees) for each Conservatory for the Performing Arts production.** Tickets can be purchased in person or via the phone at the box office. Instructions will also be provided on how to purchase your discounted tickets online, in the Fine Arts Center Share Point site.



Adjunct faculty, Graduate Student Assistants, and Full-Time Graduate Student Tickets

- Rush tickets (see above)
- Only adjuncts that are currently teaching are eligible for employee discounts
- Only currently enrolled Graduate Student Assistants and Full-Time Graduate Students are eligible for this discount.
- **Two total tickets per season.** Only Conservatory for the Performing Arts performances are eligible.
- **Tickets are \$5 each plus taxes and fees.**

Student Tickets

The following student discounts only apply to undergraduate students currently enrolled for the academic year.

- Rush tickets (see above)
- **Two \$1 tickets plus taxes (fees are waived) for each Conservatory for the Performing Arts production.** Tickets can be purchased in person or via the phone from the box office. Instructions will also be provided on how to purchase your discounted tickets online, in the Fine Arts Center Share Point site.

FSPA Tickets

Ticket discounts will be made available to Sisters only, other employees or affiliates of the FSPA will not be eligible for ticket discounts. The Fine Arts Center will secure a list of Sisters yearly from the FSPA, which will be used to determine eligibility for ticket discounts. Sisters of the FSPA will be entitled to the following discounts:

- Rush tickets (see above)
- **10% off advertised package pricing for Bright Star Season of shows.** Notifications of this discount will generally happen in May of each year, with a physical flyers or brochures being delivered to the main FSPA office for internal distribution.
- **Two \$5 tickets (plus taxes and fees) for each Conservatory for the Performing Arts production.** Tickets can be purchased in person or via the phone at the box office.
