VIII. Viterbo University Updates

- Glena Temple
 - 300 freshmen moved in today,
 - Service Saturday is planned
 - Inservice all week for staff both in person and virtual
 - Paying more attention to equality
 - Testing protocol to all students in certain groups, if someone is positive and has been in contact with others, those people must be in two-week quarantine
 - Undergraduate enrollment is up from last fall; however, 6% down in overall enrollment
 - Larger freshman class than usual coming this fall 2020
 - 1.5-2 million more expenses due to COVID





- Taken residential halls down in capacity, using Gundersen Hotel and Suites for additional healthy student housing if needed
- One building designated for quarantine
- 100% placement with graduates who reported
- 98% in field placement with graduates
- Kathy and the alumni association did a GREAT job at virtual commencement celebrations
- Over 1200 masks made for Viterbo students by Viterbo alumni and 600 notes
- FSPA prayer garden is complete and looks beautiful
- 1/3 Murphy center windows were replaced
- New strength and conditioning room in VAC
- Charge to the board: Continue to work on our strategic plan
