

Viterbo Student Voting 101

Registering to Vote vs. Voting

- You can't vote in an election unless you've registered to vote. Registration can happen when voting in person, but many people register in advance of voting. Please note: the latest date you can register to vote is the Friday before the election in which you'd like to vote.

What should I bring to register to vote at my La Crosse address?

Students without a WI Driver License or ID bring one of the following for proof of residence:

- Your voter-compliant Viterbo Student ID along with your "Student Tuition Statement for Proof of Residency" printed off Self-Service. To access or print your Student Tuition Statement for Proof of Residency off [Viterbo Self Service](#), follow these steps:
 - Once on Self Service, click on "Academics" located on side drop-down menu
 - Scroll down and click "Student Tuition Statement for Proof of Residency"
 - Print all pages of your Student Tuition Statement for Proof of Residency
- A bank statement, phone bill, credit card statement, utility bill or residential lease that bears your name and local address. A full of list documents that can illustrate proof of residency can be found at <https://elections.wi.gov/>.
- Know the last four digits of your Social Security #.

Students with a WI Driver License or ID (bring WI License/ID and one of the following):

- Your voter-compliant Viterbo Student ID along with your "Student Tuition Statement for Proof of Residency" printed off Self-Service. To access or print your Student Tuition Statement for Proof of Residency off [Viterbo Self Service](#), follow these steps:
 - Once on Self Service, click on "Academics" located on side drop-down menu
 - Scroll down and click "Student Tuition Statement for Proof of Residency"
 - Print all pages of your Student Tuition Statement for Proof of Residency
- A bank statement, phone bill, credit card statement, utility bill or residential lease that bears your name and local address. A full of list documents that can illustrate proof of residency can be found at <https://elections.wi.gov/>.

***Proof of residence can be shown in electronic format.*

What should I bring to vote (I am already registered at my La Crosse address)?

- Your voter-compliant Viterbo Student ID along with your "Student Tuition Statement" printed off Self-Service (see above for instructions on how to access).
- Passport
- Military ID
- Wisconsin Driver License or ID card
- See www.bringit.wi.gov for full list of acceptable photo ID

Where do I vote?

- Viterbo students living on campus in Bonaventure, Marian, McDonald, Rose, La Verna, or Treacy vote at Coulee Recovery Center, 933 Ferry St., La Crosse, WI, 54601.
- Viterbo students living on campus in Canticle or Clare vote at the Southside Neighborhood Center, 1300 6th Street South, La Crosse, WI, 54601.

- Off-Campus students can find their polling place at <https://myvote.wi.gov/en-US/FindMyPollingPlace>
- All students may register and vote at La Crosse City Hall (400 La Crosse Street) two weeks before Election Day (see [Elections & Voting webpage](#) for specific times). *This is a great option as there won't be lines and staff can assist you! City Hall is a 20-minute walk or free 14-minute bus ride (w/VU ID); plan your bus trip at <https://www.cityoflacrosse.org/your-government/departments/municipal-transit-mtu>*

What time can I vote on Election Day?

- The polling sites listed above are open from 7a.m.-8p.m. on Election Day.
