Estimated Costs Per Year

Scholarships

First-year undergraduates may qualify for academic scholarships up to \$16,000 per year based upon their secondary GPA. Transfer undergraduate students may receive academic scholarships up to \$10,000 per year. There may also be opportunities for athletic and/or departmental scholarships.

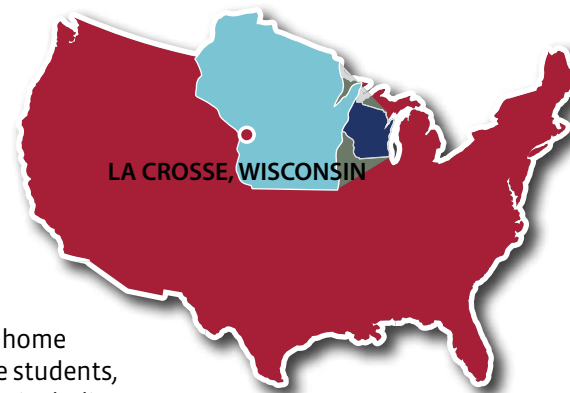

Viterbo University in La Crosse, Wisconsin, is a Catholic, Franciscan university founded in 1890 by the Franciscan Sisters of Perpetual Adoration that prepares students for faithful service and ethical leadership. Viterbo is a co-educational liberal arts institution with renowned programs in nursing, business, education, and the fine arts.

Viterbo has more than 40 undergraduate programs of study and seven graduate programs, so Viterbo students have academic choices that compare to larger universities.
