	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • One year of chemistry, or equivalency, with grade of C or better • Two years of algebra, or equivalency, with grades of C or better <p>Test scores will not be used to determine placement for incoming first-year students. Because of the already strong predictive ability of high school grade point averages, placement into the direct or holistic admission tracks will be test-blind.</p>	
FIRST YEAR	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 3.50 GPA minimum <p>Students meeting this minimum threshold and passing their nursing prerequisites below will be guaranteed a fall or spring sophomore year professional sequence start.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • High school rank in the 50th percentile or higher—if no class rank, minimum high school GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale <p>Students meeting this minimum threshold will be admitted to the nursing major and will then have the opportunity to apply for the nursing professional sequence via a holistic process.</p> <p>Students not meeting one of the minimum requirements above, may be admitted to Viterbo as a pre-nursing student. Upon successful completion of preparatory work, pre-nursing students will be admitted into the nursing major and follow the same processes and subsequent holistic application for the professional sequence.</p>

(For spring semester professional sequence starts, the priority deadline to apply is Nov. 1.)
<p>Requirements* to be completed before beginning the nursing professional sequence:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • CPR for Professionals card from the American Heart Association – BLS for Health Care Providers • Current documentation of state CNA certification (any state) • Nursing physical form, immunizations, and vaccinations (including Covid-19 complete series) • Criminal background check • Nursing math test through the Academic Resource Center <p>*Specific requirements may change based on regulatory, licensing, and/or certification needs.</p>		



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Additional Information on Holistic Admission

The Nursing Admission Committee reviews student records after the posting of current semester grades. The committee will admit the most qualified students based on a holistic review of items that may include cumulative GPA, cumulative GPA in prerequisite courses, science GPA, previous academic records, interview, essay, or other supplemental items.

Entrance is competitive. Capacity for professional sequence enrollment is 125 new fall semester starts and 75 new spring semester starts. If a Viterbo student were ever to be denied admission into the professional sequence based on capacity limits, a spot would be guaranteed for them the following term, provided that they remain enrolled full time and maintain the academic criteria noted above.
