## TRANSFER ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIPS

Viterbo awards academic scholarships to new full-time transfer students enrolling in traditional undergraduate programs upon official acceptance. Online bachelor completion programs are excluded from these scholarships. Transfer students should also apply for additional scholarships and complete the FAFSA so we can award all federal, state, or institutional aid available based on merit, need, talent, and the major program of study.\* The FAFSA priority filing deadline for fall 2025 is **Feb. 1, 2025**.

\*Admitted students have until June 1 to submit improved transcripts to attempt to increase their academic scholarship.

## NEED-BASED FINANCIAL AID

To apply for need-based financial aid (grants, particular scholarships, tuition promise, work-study, or loans), file the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). To ensure consideration for all financial aid options, complete the FAFSA and any additional required documentation prior to Viterbo’s priority date of Feb. 1, 2025. ## ADDITIONAL SCHOLARSHIPS FOR INCOMING TRANSFER STUDENTS

Below is an overview of additional scholarship categories for incoming transfer students. To maximize your financial aid eligibility, we recommend you be admitted by Jan. 15, 2025, complete any required scholarship applications by the deadlines listed, and file the FAFSA before the priority date of Feb. 1, 2025.

\*Scholarships and deadlines are subject to change and are competitively awarded. Some scholarships may require earlier completion.

### AREAS OF INTEREST

Students planning to major in applied mathematics and analytics, communication disorders and sciences, computer science, criminal and community justice, ECAS, education, engineering, psychology, or social work.

### WESTERN

Students who transfer from Western Technical College may be eligible for the Jack and Rose Glendenning Scholarship and the Western Technical College Transfer Student Scholarship.

### ATHLETIC

As a member of the National Association of Intercollegiate Athletics (NAIA), scholarship money may be awarded to varsity student-athletes based on athletic ability.

### MILITARY

Recognized as a Military Friendly School and Yellow Ribbon School, Viterbo offers military tuition discounts (if eligible) and federal aid offerings.

### ALUMNI

Students whose parent or legal guardian is an alumnus of Viterbo University.

### DIVERSITY

Students who have a diverse ethnic or racial background may be eligible for additional scholarships.

### PERFORMING ARTS

Talent scholarships for students interested in music (both majors and non-majors), theatre, and music theatre. These scholarships require an audition.

### PHI THETA KAPPA

Phi Theta Kappa members who intend to enroll full-time in a traditional undergraduate program at Viterbo University in the fall semester.
