• Tier 1: unlimited meals, \$150 VHB* OR 260 meals, \$250 VHB*	(FY+) \$3,290 x 2 =	\$6,580
• Tier 2: 230 meals, \$300 VHB* OR 190 meals, \$400 VHB*	(SO+) \$2,750 x 2 =	\$5,500
• Tier 3: 160 meals, \$450 VHB* OR 120 meals, \$550 VHB*	(JR+) \$2,260 x 2 =	\$4,520
• Commuter: \$600 VHB* <i>open to commuter students only.</i>	\$600 x 2 =	\$1,200
