Transfer Academic Scholarships

Viterbo University awards academic scholarships to new full-time transfer students enrolling in our traditional undergraduate programs upon official acceptance. (Online bachelor's completion programs are not eligible for these scholarships.)

Transfer students are encouraged to apply for additional scholarships and complete the FAFSA to ensure access to all available federal, state, and institutional aid based on merit, need, talent, and program of study. The FAFSA priority filing deadline for fall 2026 is Feb. 1, 2026. Admitted students may submit updated transcripts by June 1 to be considered for an increased academic scholarship award.

Need-Based Financial Aid

Additional Scholarships for Incoming Transfer Students

Viterbo University offers a variety of additional scholarships for incoming transfer students. To make the most of your financial aid opportunities, we recommend:

- Apply and be admitted by **Jan. 15, 2026**.
- Complete any required scholarship applications by their listed deadlines.
- Submit your FAFSA by the priority date of **Feb. 1, 2026**.

WESTERN

Students who transfer from Western Technical College may be eligible for the Jack and Rose Glendenning Scholarship and the Western Technical College Transfer Student Scholarship.

ATHLETIC

As a member of the National Association of Intercollegiate Athletics (NAIA), scholarship money may be awarded to varsity student-athletes based on athletic ability.

PERFORMING ARTS

Talent scholarships for students interested in music (both majors and non-majors), theatre, and music theatre. These scholarships require an audition.

MILITARY

Recognized as a Military Friendly School and Yellow Ribbon School, Viterbo offers military tuition discounts (if eligible) and federal aid offerings.

ALUMNI

Students whose parent or legal guardian is an alumnus of Viterbo University.

DIVERSITY

Students who have a diverse ethnic or racial background may be eligible for additional scholarships.

PHI THETA KAPPA

Phi Theta Kappa members who intend to enroll full-time in a traditional undergraduate program at Viterbo University in the fall semester.
