### WI County and Tribal Veteran Service Officer Association Scholarship Application

Three \$1,000 annual scholarships will be awarded to a child or spouse of a Veteran to pursue a post-secondary education program at an accredited university, college, or school. Awardees are eligible to receive the scholarship once. Applicants must be a Wisconsin resident. Scholarship may be used to cover tuition, fees, books, room, or board. The scholarship will be paid to the student after the C/TVSOA receives a letter from the school registrar's office stating the student is enrolled full time in an accredited institution in pursuit of a postsecondary education program.

**C/TVSO Association Mission Statement:** The County and Tribal Veterans Service Officers Association of Wisconsin (C/TVSO) is an organization of professional Veterans advocates. In Wisconsin, the County and Tribal Veterans Service Officers play a critical role in the Veteran's advocacy system and is often the initial contact in the community for Veteran's services. #### **Scholarship Eligibility:**

- Be a spouse or child of a Veteran who meets WI § 45.01(12) eligibility
  - Note: Children or spouses of current County or Tribal Veteran Service Offices are <u>not</u> eligible
- Children may be biological, adopted, or stepchildren between the ages of 17-25
- Spouses: No age restrictions
- Be a current WI resident
- Enrolled or will be enrolled by September 2026 at an accredited school or university for a postsecondary program
- Applications are judged by a panel, based on merit.
- Scan and submit application with all supporting documents to: scholarship@wicvso.org
- Applications accepted: December 1, 2025-March 15, 2026

- A copy of a valid WI driver's license, school ID, or state-issued ID
