It includes designing an experiment, literature review, data collection and analysis. Topics include the effect of color on memory, empathy in juror decision making, and the effect of gender and social media profiles on evaluations of job candidates.

11:30-1:30PM	Poster	RCE Lobby	Luke Bussiere	<b>BIOL 250-Frankenstien's yeast: Functional consequences of cross-species gene swapping:</b> BIOL.250 students will present posters on their semester-long research projects exploring whether genes from one yeast species can functionally replace missing genes in another. These genes encode proteins involved in methionine biosynthesis, producing an essential amino acid required for protein synthesis and cell survival. Together, these studies investigate how conserved these proteins are across distantly related yeasts.
