



Student Graduation Rates

The Department of Education requires the disaggregated reporting of student graduation rates. The data is based on our first-time, full-time, baccalaureate-seeking cohort, which typically represents less than 12% of our overall student enrollment.

The data below represents the graduation rates of the cohort who entered Viterbo in the Fall of 2019; and are shown by type of Title IV aid, gender, race, and ethnicity.
