## MBA Sample Schedule

*Note: Incoming students without a business degree take MGMT 501 Foundations of Business in their first semester.*

*Core MBA courses are generally taken one at a time, one evening per week, so two courses are completed each semester. An exception to this format is the semester in which MGMT 525/565 are taken concurrently over 16 weeks, still one evening per week from 6-10pm. Some courses are also offered in a blended format, with face to face meetings approximately once per month and the rest of the content delivered online.*
